# Grayslake Historical Society

## PURPOSE

- ✓ To bring together those people interested in the history and background of Grayslake and its surrounding area.
- ✓ To collect, preserve and display the memorials of its founders and benefactors as well as the historical evidence and artifacts of its progress and improvement in relation to population, the arts and institutions.
- ✓ To transmit the same for the instruction and benefit of future generations.

## RESEARCH LIBRARY

The Historical Society has a research library containing oral histories, an obituary file, maps, pictures and an extensive file of local newspaper clippings. Research can be done by the museum staff for a nominal fee.

## EXHIBITS

Museum exhibits are located on two floors of the Heritage Center and in the large annex building. The first floor of the Heritage Center has a temporary gallery with changing displays and three temporary display cases in the lobby. Temporary exhibits are displayed for special events in the area, to highlight particular collections and to inform the public of certain historical facts.

The second floor of the Heritage Center contains both temporary and permanent exhibits.

A 1954 fire truck made in Grayslake, a horse-drawn hearse and an award-winning farm exhibit are of special interest in the Annex.

## PROGRAMS

The Society meets at 7:00 pm on the second Wednesday of the month in September, October, November, March, April and May at the Grayslake Heritage Center.
